### Accommodation

### Train Vélo Loire

From 11 June to 11 September 2016

You can take your bike on the Inter-loire from Orléans to Le Croisic free of charge and without booking. The Centre Val de Loire and Pays de la Loire Regions offer you a unique service: Special staff will load, stow and unload your bike in a specially equipped train coach that can carry up to 34 bikes.\*

\* bike transport within the limit of available spaces for bikes whose size does not exceed that of a tandem and on presentation of a valid ticket.

- Works **without an internet connection** (except upon launch to download the maps)

- The chance to **set yourself challenges** throughout the route and win virtual trophies!

And many more features: weather forecasts along the route, cyclists' experiences and photos, route suggestions, a "Good Deal" section, and more.

The app is available in English and French in iPhone and Android versions.

From Cuffly in Cher to Saint-Brevin-les-Pins in Loire-Atlantique, the «Loire à Vélo» route is laid out section by section. The «Loire à Vélo» trail offers more than 800 kilometres of routes available.
